These benefits are neither offered nor guaranteed under contract with the FEHBP but are made available to all FEHBP eligible enrollees and their covered family members. You cannot file an FEHBP disputed claim about them. The premiums and fees you pay do not count toward FEHBP deductibles or out-of-pocket maximums.

An annual \$5 American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE) associate membership fee makes this plan available to you. This fee will be debited at the end of February each year. This will be a separate debit from your premium debit. AFGE members are exempt from this fee. Dental coverage is provided by Kaiser Foundation Health plan of the Northwest.
